

## Meeting Summary

**Attending:** Rudy Matcham (Del Rey), Brooke Frost (Fresno County), Debra McKenzie (Fresno County), Ellie Palomo (Sanger) Thomas Klose (Sanger)

**State Update:** Ellie reported that March 19 a new claim for reimbursement was sent in, once the funds have been received they will be distributed as outlined.

Second round of CalGRIP funding was awarded! Communities That Care Gang Task Force was the only city in Fresno County to be funded<sup>1</sup>. Ellie will work with [CalEMA](#) (formerly OES) staff to modify/correct budget of new grant package. Once this is done an Award Letter can be sent out and she will forward that along with the application and budget out to all partners.

CA Consulting has agreed to do all administration (included finances) for the grant as funds were written in to cover this. City of Sanger will discuss how to proceed on using the administration funding and report at the next meeting.
